

## Winegrowers/Blenders Report ABC-261

### Frequently Asked Questions

**Q. What do I enter on Line 1?**

A. For Type 02, Winegrowers License, enter the number of gallons of wine that you produced between July 1 and June 30. (This is the number reported to the TTB on federal form TTB F 5120.17 on line number 2).

For Type 22, Wine Blenders License, enter the number of gallons of wine that you blended between July 1 and June 30. (This is the number reported to the TTB on federal form TTB F 5120.17 on line number 5).

**Q. What if I have a Type 02, Winegrowers License and also blended wine purchased from another Winegrower?**

A. Add the total number of gallons of wine produced under your Type 02, Winegrowers License and the total number of gallons of wine blended that was purchased from other winegrowers. (Add the numbers reported to the TTB on federal form TTB F 5120.17 on line number 2 and 5).

**Q. How is Blended defined?**

A. For purposes of completing Form ABC-261, Winegrowers/Blenders Report, report the number of gallons of wine that you produced (fermented) together with the wine that you purchased (if any) from another winegrower that was used as “blending material.” We do NOT want you to report any of your own wine that you used to blend with other wine that you produced.

*Note: if you purchased wine from another winery (that may or may not have already been blended by the seller) and merely bottle that wine without blending any of it yourself, you would NOT report this gallonage on the ABC-261.*

**Q. What is the number entered on Line 3?**

A. This is the fee paid by you the prior year and has been entered for you on Line 3 by the Department and must not to be changed by you.

**Q. What if the fee for Line 2 is less than the amount being credited on Line 3?**

A. Line 4 will show an overpayment and this will be automatically refunded to you by the Department.

**Q. What if the fee for Line 2 is more than the amount being credited on Line 3?**

A. Line 4 will show the balance due and you should remit a check for this amount with the ABC-261.

**Q. What if I have a balance due of zero on Line 4?**

A. You are still required to return the signed and dated form to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control by September 30.
