ABC Posts Notice of Revocation at Canoga Park Restaurant
Agents Discover Numerous Sales of Alcohol to Minors at the location

Canoga Park- On December 8, 2016, Agents from the California Alcoholic Beverage Control posted a Notice of Revocation at Mi Sombrero Azul, an ABC licensed business located at 20039 Vanowen Street in Canoga Park also known as Trejos Restaurant. The license has been revoked because the premises sold alcohol to minors three times in the past three years. Effective immediately, sales of alcohol are prohibited at the business.

“This action is part of an ongoing partnership with local law enforcement to reduce underage drinking and help keep young people safe,” said Brad Beach, ABC Van Nuys Supervising Agent in Charge.

Underage drinking results in too many young lives lost in car crashes, alcohol poisonings and other incidents, and therefore everyone is reminded to be vigilant in preventing alcohol from getting into the hands of minors. ABC encourages all licensed businesses that sell alcohol to send their managers and employees to Licensee Education on Alcohol and Drugs (LEAD) training. LEAD is a program that provides attendees with practical information on serving alcoholic beverages safely, responsibly, and legally, with emphasis on preventing sales to minors, sales to obviously intoxicated persons, and illicit drug activity at the licensed establishment. This type of training not only helps businesses better understand their responsibilities, but also provides them with the tools and knowledge they need to promote reasonable consumption and contribute to making communities safer.
