ABC Suspends Restaurant License in King City for 20 Days State also puts the license on probation for one year

(King City) On February 9, 2017, ABC Agents posted a 20 day suspension at Eve's Enchiladas Restaurant Authentic Mexican Food located at 103 Bassett St., King City. The restaurant is not allowed to sell alcohol during the suspension period, which resulted from violations in 2016 of serving alcohol to minors and illegally selling distilled spirits while only holding beer and wine privileges. In addition, the ABC license has been placed on probation for one year and faces further suspension if any similar violations occur.

"Selling alcohol to minors puts young people at risk. ABC will discipline locations that allow this to occur in order to increase protections for youth and build stronger and safer communities," said Acting ABC Director Ramona Prieto.
