## **ABC REVOKES LIQUOR LICENSE OF RANCHO CUCAMONGA STORE**

ABC Investigators today posted a notice announcing the revocation of the alcoholic beverage license issued to the premises of Cheers Liquor, 12838 Foothill Blvd. in Rancho Cucamonga following an investigation.

ABC investigators who worked closely with Corona Police developed information that the store owner knowingly purchased stolen gasoline and received delivery of stolen goods at his ABC licensed premises. The investigation also revealed the store owner was involved in conspiracy to steal the gasoline.

The Department received a police report from the Corona Police Department concerning an investigation where the driver of a fuel delivery company conspired with the store owner to deliver stolen gasoline to his premises. Additionally, ABC investigators learned the owner paid the driver between 50 and 60 cents a gallon for the unauthorized loads which normal retail customers would have been charged about a \$1.40 per gallon. It is estimated that \$50,000.00 worth of fuel was illegally delivered to the premises.

The revocation takes effect immediately. The current licensee will not be able to sell any liquor at this store and no new license will be issued for at least one year. For more information contact ABC District Administrator Tim Clark in the Riverside office at 1-951-782-4400.
