ABC AND SAN GABRIEL POLICE SHUT DOWN LUCKY LADY SALOON IN SAN GABRIEL FOR ALCOHOL LAW VIOLATIONS

San Gabriel – ABC Investigators along with San Gabriel Police today posted a revocation notice at the Lucky Lady Saloon, 314 – 314 ½ San Gabriel Boulevard in San Gabriel following a long investigation involving purported stolen property and illegal narcotics transactions.

Last year authorities arrested the bar owner, a male bartender, a female bartender and a patron of the Lucky Lady Saloon. During the investigation, undercover investigators were able to make purchases of illegal drugs from the female bartender and were also able to sell purported stolen cigarettes to the bar owner. In addition, the male bartender was charged with facilitating a sale of illegal narcotics and investigators arrested a bar patron who was in possession of methamphetamines for purposes of resale.

ABC worked closely with the San Gabriel Police because there were numerous complaints about this location in the community. ABC investigators went undercover multiple times to develop information that led to the arrests.

ABC filed an accusation against the bar owner and the final penalty is revocation of the license with an indefinite stay to allow for a double transfer of the license. This means the owner loses the license and no alcohol will be served at this location for at least one year. The double transfer of the license means the license will be transferred to another person at another location. Anyone who is issued an alcohol license in California is subject to a background investigation by ABC.
