## **ABC REVOKES ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE OF SAN JOSE BAR**

**San Jose**— The California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) has revoked the alcoholic beverage license of the Cazadores Bar & Nightclub, 1621-A, Almaden Road in San Jose for illegal activity. The ABC took administrative action against the business because of violations that occurred back in 2003.

ABC filed an accusation in 2003 because the business allowed the sale of cocaine, the illegal solicitation of alcohol by one of the bar employees and permitted lewd acts within the licensed premises.

“We are hoping that our enforcement will help reduce crime and increase the quality of life in this community,” said ABC Chief Deputy Director Dave Goss.

The ABC worked closely with San Jose Police during the course of its investigation.

The revocation posting occurred last week. It means the owner of this business can no longer sell alcohol at this location and has lost the license to sell alcohol in California.
