**DAVE GOSS APPOINTED CHIEF DEPUTY DIRECTOR FOR ABC
BY GOVERNOR SCHWARZENEGGER**

Goss will handle Acting Director Duties

Sacramento – David Goss, 61, of El Dorado Hills, has been appointed Chief Deputy Director for the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger. Goss has served the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for more than 29 years, most recently as a retired annuitant helping on special projects. Previously, Goss held the positions of assistant director of the northern division, deputy division chief and chief of internal affairs and training for ABC.

Goss has served in other capacities with ABC during his 29 years, including Investigator, Supervising Investigator, District Administrator, Deputy Division Chief and Assistant Director, Northern Division for 13 years prior to his retirement in 2000. Goss spent 5 years as a Retired Annuitant (2000-2005) working on Special Projects prior to his recent Chief Deputy Director appointment. Goss was instrumental in a number of Grant Programs including Every 15 Minutes, Drug Enforcement Narcotics Team (DENT) and the Grant Assistance to Local Law Enforcement (GALE) program before it turned into the Grant Assistance Program (GAP).

In his new capacity as Chief Deputy Director, Goss will be the department's Acting Director in place of Jerry R. Jolly, who retired from the department August 31, 2006 after 31 years of service.
