ABC Suspends License of Folsom Establishment

Location pays \$6,000 fine and is not to sell alcohol for five days

(Folsom) - Investigators of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) have posted a Notice of Suspension at a licensed location named Power House Pub located at 614 Sutter Street in Folsom.

The action was taken on Thursday, February 19, 2009 after ABC had filed two separate accusations against the licensed business.

The Power House Pub alcoholic beverage license has been suspended for five days because of an accusation that it allowed a minor to enter and remain inside the premises, which is a violation of the California Business and Professions Code. The suspension means no alcoholic beverages will be sold, served, or consumed at this location during this time.

In addition, the owners of the business were ordered to pay a \$6,000 fine to the State of California for a second accusation that the Power House Pub offered a coupon that allowed customers a free alcoholic beverage, and for possessing a contaminated alcoholic beverage on the premises.

ABC is a department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency, which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor's Cabinet.
