ABC Suspends License of Store in Julian for 45 Days *Store Sold Alcohol to Minors Three Times in Three Year Period*

Julian - On April 23, 2009, the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) suspended the alcoholic beverage license of the Julian Market and Deli (Airos Inc.), located at 2220 Main Street in Julian. The suspension will last 45 days. The enforcement action is a result of an ABC investigation that substantiated evidence of three separate sales of alcoholic beverages to minors. The sales occurred on June 16, 2005, December 19, 2005, and on March 27, 2008.

The store will not be allowed to sell alcohol during the 45 day suspension period.

“This action is part of an ongoing enforcement effort statewide to help keep young persons safe,” said ABC District Supervisor Robin Van Dyke. “ABC is pressing forward with an effort to increase compliance with the law through strong enforcement. Selling or furnishing alcohol to minors will not be tolerated.”

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor’s Cabinet.
