**ABC Suspends License of “Vault Ultra Lounge” in San Jose***Location is not to sell alcohol for 35 days*

**(San Jose)** - Investigators of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) have posted a Notice of Suspension at a licensed location named Vault Ultra Lounge located at 81 West Santa Clara Avenue in downtown San Jose.

The action was taken on Thursday, November 5, 2009 after ABC had filed two separate accusations against the licensed business.

The alcoholic beverage license has been suspended for 35 days because of an accusation that a minor was allowed to enter and remain inside the premises in December of 2006, a violation of the California Business and Professions Code. A separate accusation was filed due to the premises and owners being in violation of the Labor Code stemming from a multi-agency inspection in March of 2008. The suspension means no alcoholic beverages will be sold, served, or consumed at this location during this time.

The San Jose Police Department is currently an ABC Grant Assistance Program (GAP) recipient and works closely with ABC to enforce alcoholic beverage laws.

ABC is a department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency, which is under the direction of Secretary Dale E. Bonner, a member of the Governor’s Cabinet.
