**License Revoked at Woodland Establishment for Operating a “Disorderly House”**  
*“La Finca” will no longer be able to Sell Alcohol*

**Woodland** - Investigators of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) today posted a Notice of Revocation at La Finca, a bar and restaurant licensed by the ABC. La Finca is losing its license because the bar has been operating a “Disorderly House” and has been a drain on law enforcement services. The premises has been the focus of numerous calls for police services from the Woodland Police Department for fights, assaults, public drunkenness and a shooting on March 6, 2011 that resulted in the murder of a 30 year old man just outside the business.

ABC worked closely with Woodland Police during an investigation that spanned several months. ABC filed an accusation against La Finca for multiple ABC violations including sales to a minor, employment of a minor who was involved in the service of alcohol, license condition violations and because the owners were operating a “Disorderly House.”

After negotiations between ABC and the owners of La Finca, the owners agreed to a revocation of the license. The bar and restaurant owners understand they are no longer allowed to sell alcohol. La Finca is located at 534 Bush Street in Woodland.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency.
