## **License Suspended at 76 Food Mart for Illegal Marijuana Operation** *Store in Yuba City must stop selling alcohol*

**Yuba City** - Agents of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) have posted a Notice of Suspension at 76 Food Mart, located at 1466 Colusa Avenue in Yuba City. The license has been suspended for 30 days and indefinitely thereafter until transferred to a person or persons acceptable to the Department.

The suspension is the result of an investigation conducted by the Yuba/Sutter Narcotic and Gang Enforcement Team (NET-5) of an illegal marijuana growing operation. On June 4, 2013, NET-5 executed a search warrant at the 76 Food Mart. During the search warrant, Agents located approximately 92 marijuana plants and associated indoor growing equipment.

ABC filed an accusation against the 76 Food Mart for allowing the illegal growing of marijuana.

The owner of 76 Food Mart signed a stipulation and waiver agreeing to the penalty. The agreement spells out that beginning on December 4, 2013; the license is suspended for 30 days and indefinitely thereafter to allow the owner to sell the license to another person or persons acceptable to the ABC.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency.
