**ABC Suspends License of Bboss Restaurant in San Jose**  
*The Business will not be able to sell Alcohol for 30 Days*

SAN JOSE – On April 17, 2014, Agents of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) posted a Notice of Suspension at Bboss Restaurant located at 385 North Capitol Avenue in San Jose for lewd acts, allowing minors to consume alcoholic beverages inside the premises, and violating conditions on its license.

The license of Bboss Restaurant has been suspended for 30 days and the restaurant has been placed on probation for an additional 15 days.

Between January, 2014 and April, 2014 the premises was in violation of state alcoholic beverage laws by permitting their employees to conduct lewd acts, and allowing minors to consume alcoholic beverages inside the premises on two separate occasions. In addition, the owner was in violation of their conditional license, specifically, allowing sales, service, and consumption of alcohol after their conditioned hours, allowing entertainment audible beyond their premises, and storing open bottles of distilled spirits for specific customers.

Undercover ABC Agents and local law enforcement agencies visited the premises multiple times during the four month period and discovered the violations.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Consumer Services, and Housing Agency.
