PR 14-17**License Suspended at Crogan's Sports Bar for Operating a "Disorderly House"**  
*No Alcohol Sales will be Allowed for 20 Day Period*

**Walnut Creek** - Agents of the California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) have posted a Notice of Suspension at Crogan's Sports Bar and Grill located at 1387 Locust Street in Walnut Creek. The Crogan's Sports Bar and Grill alcoholic beverage license has been suspended for 20 days and placed on probation for two-years because the bar had been operating a "Disorderly House" constituting a drain on law enforcement services.

The premises has been the focus of numerous calls for police services from the Walnut Creek Police Department for fights, assaults, public drunkenness and other public nuisance issues. ABC worked closely with officers of the Walnut Creek Police Department.

ABC filed an accusation against the premises because there were over 200 calls for service to the licensed premises during the reporting period of August, 2012 to November, 2013. Over 30 of those calls warranted a criminal report by the Walnut Creek Police Department.

The licensee stipulated to the accusation and accepted the Department's penalty of a 20 day suspension and two years of probation.

Crogan's license was suspended for 10 days in 2008 for selling alcohol to a minor and it was suspended 15 days in 2010 for serving an obviously intoxicated patron and allowing public drunkenness.

ABC posted the most recent suspension on Thursday, April 17, 2014. ABC is a Department of the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency.
