ABC Suspends License of Kenny's Bar and Grill in Woodland
30 Day suspension for business operated as a 'Disorderly House'

Davis- Agents of the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) today posted a Notice of Suspension at Kenny's Bar and Grill, located at 721 E Street in the city of Woodland. The business is prohibited from serving or selling alcohol for 30 days and the license has been placed on probation for two years.

The suspension is the result of an investigation conducted by the ABC and the Woodland Police Department related to ongoing disorderly operation of the business, as defined by California Business and Professions Code section 25601.

From January, 2014 through December, 2015, police were required to respond and take action at the business location numerous times for incidents such as fights, assaults, public drunkenness and disturbing the peace. On December 5, 2015, a patron was stabbed to death during a fight inside the business.

Upon completion of the suspension, the ABC could move to permanently revoke the business's license if the licensee allows similar levels of disorderly activity to occur at any time during the two-year probationary period.

ABC is a Department of the Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency.
